Drawings and Technical Information

No separate written specification document has been prepared for this project.

Tenderers shall ensure that all drawings, notes, schedules and referenced information have been reviewed in full and that adequate provision has been made within the Tender Sum for the proper execution and completion of the Works in accordance with the Contract Documents.

Interpretation of Tender Documents

The Tender Documents shall be read as complementary documents and, insofar as possible, interpreted to give effect to the overall intent of the proposed Works.

The order of precedence of the Contract Documents following award of the Contract shall be as set out in the Public Works Contract, PW-CF5 v2.9.

Nothing contained within these Tender Documents shall amend, vary or override the provisions of the Form of Contract.

Tenderer's Responsibility

Submission of a Tender shall constitute confirmation by the Tenderer that:

- The Tenderer has examined the Tender Documents in full.
- The Tenderer has familiarised itself with the nature and extent of the Works.
- The Tenderer has reviewed the information contained within the appendices issued as part of the Tender Package.
- The Tenderer has allowed for all obligations necessary to complete the Works in accordance with the Contract Documents.
- The Tenderer has taken account of all matters that could reasonably have been identified from examination of the Tender Documents and inspection of the Site.
- The Tenderer has sought clarification of any ambiguity, discrepancy or conflict identified prior to submission of its Tender.
