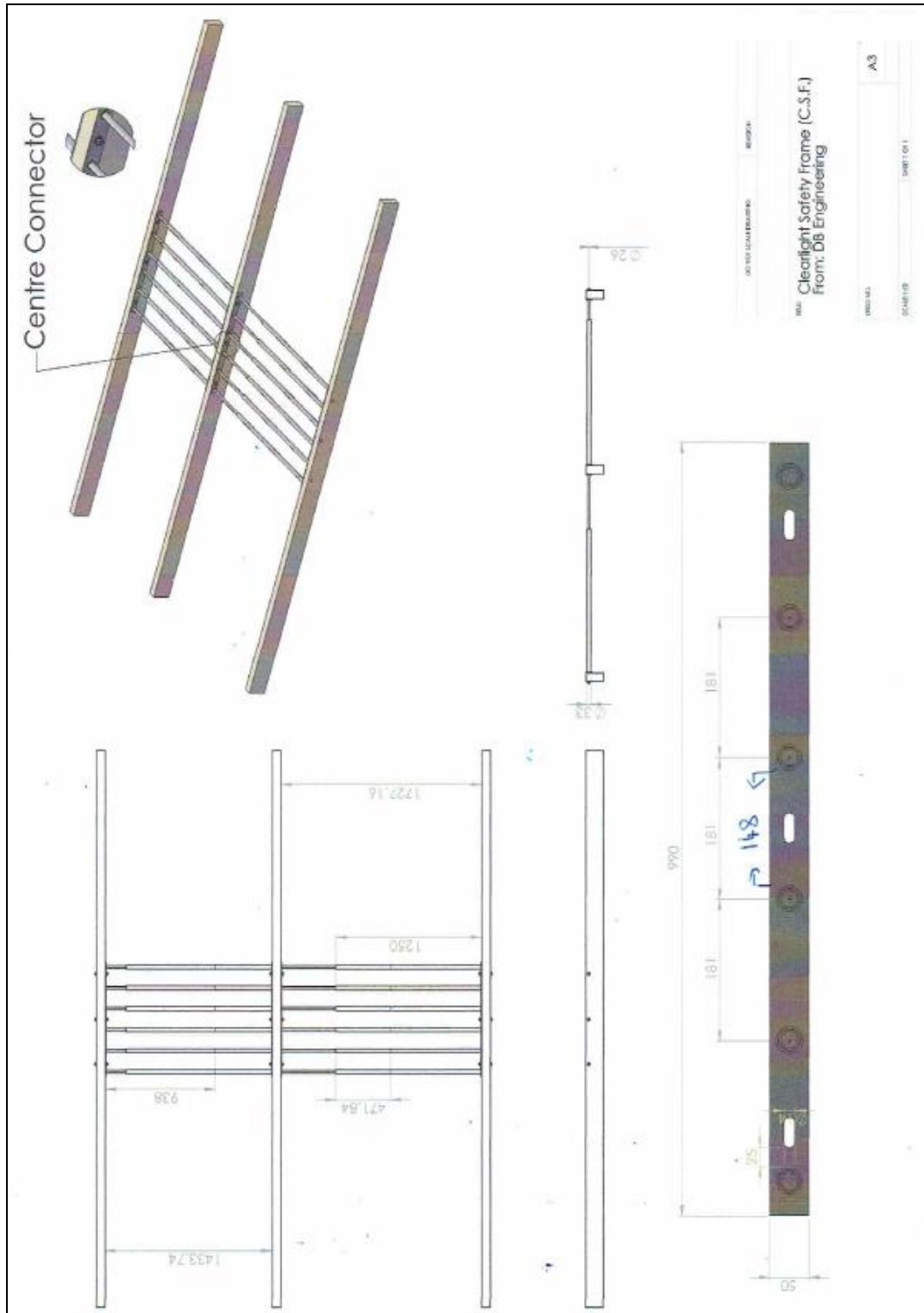

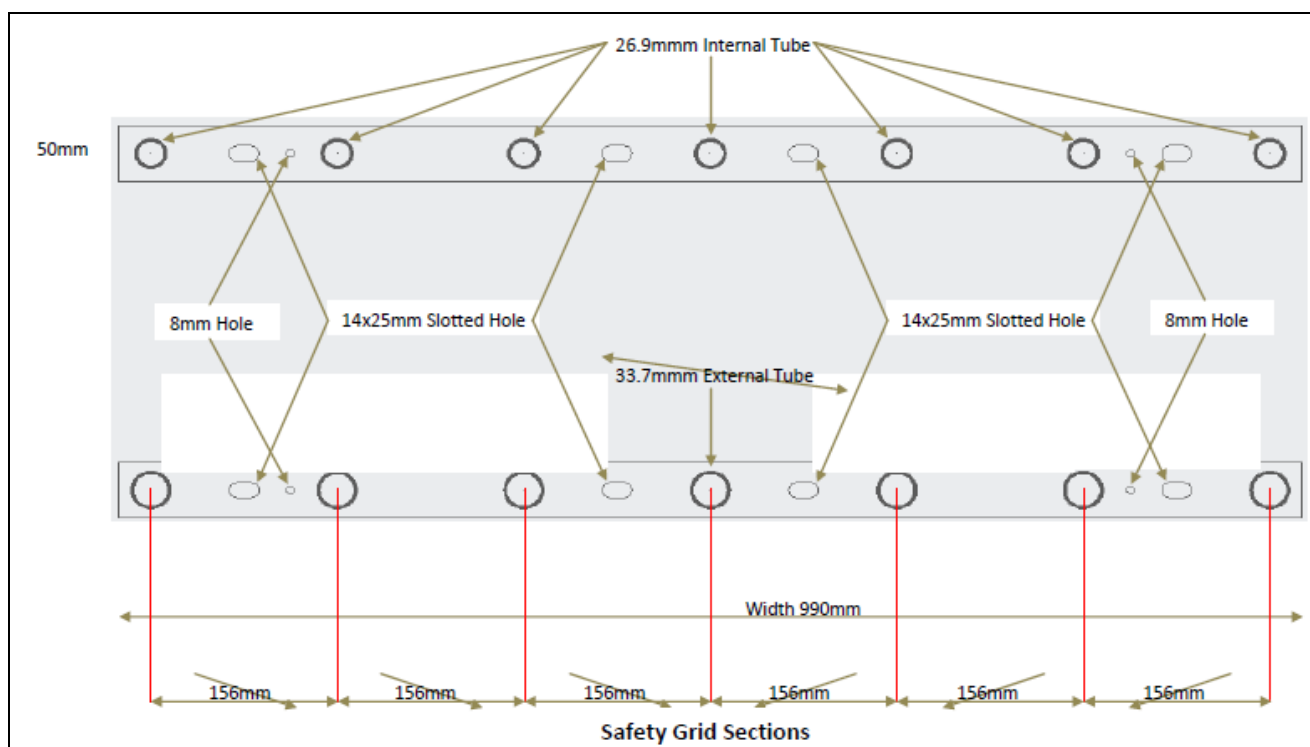
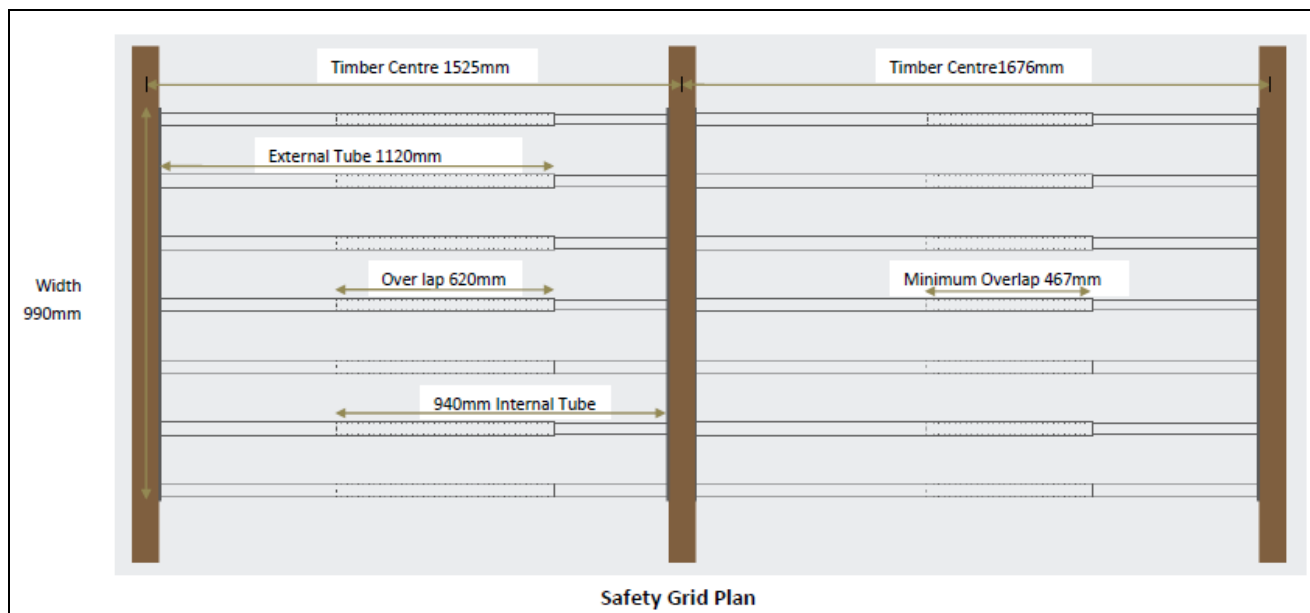
The unit is to be fully galvanised. *Grids secured using 3 No 20mm bolts fully through purlins.*





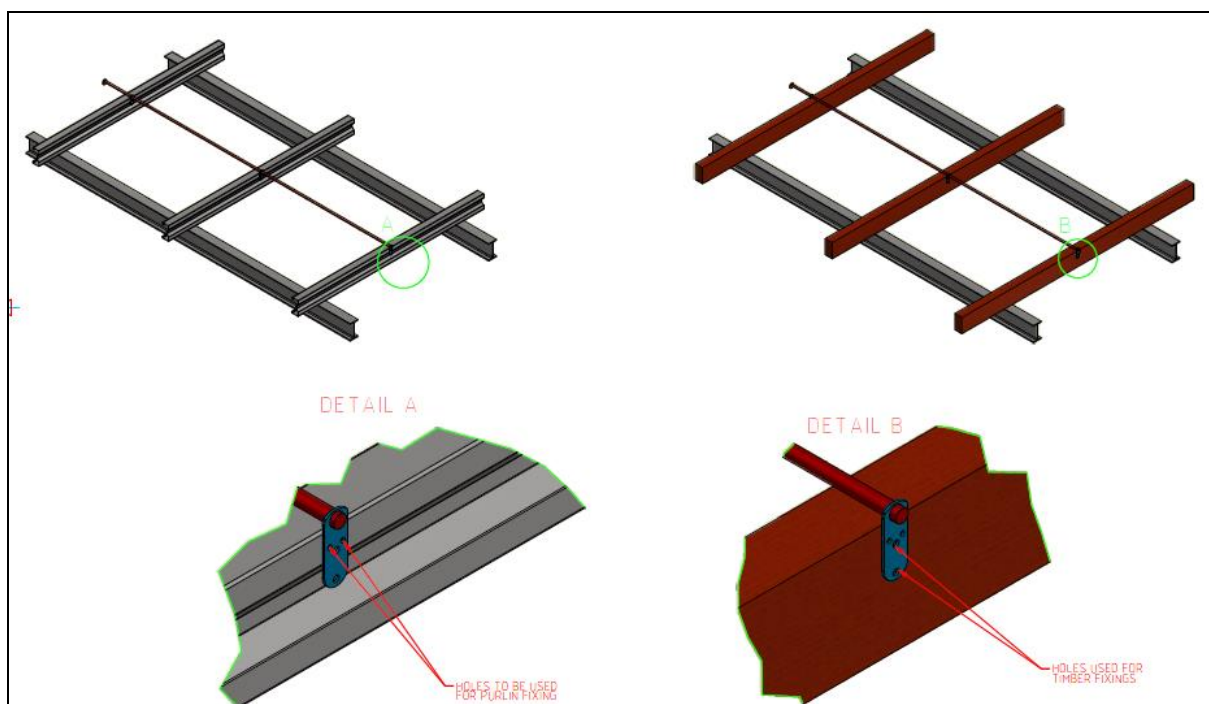
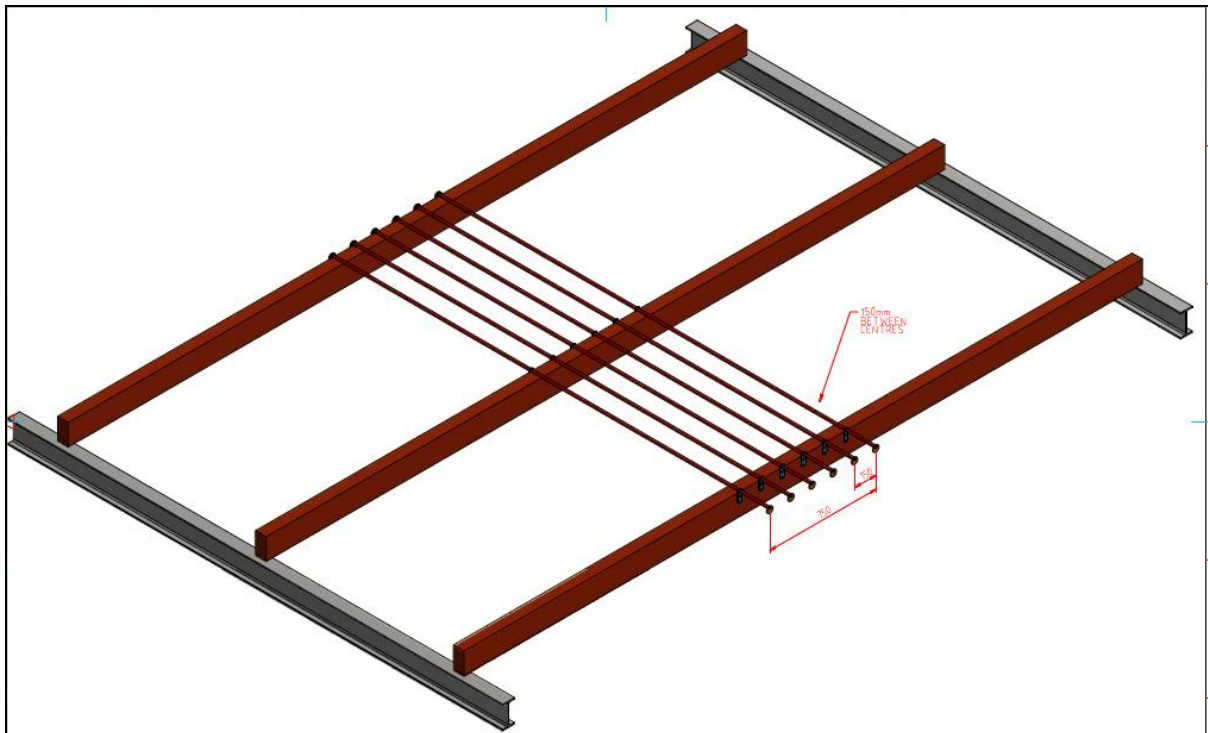

The unit is to be fully galvanised. The unit is to be secured using 4No M12 x 100mm 8.8 grade galvanized bolts at each purlin.





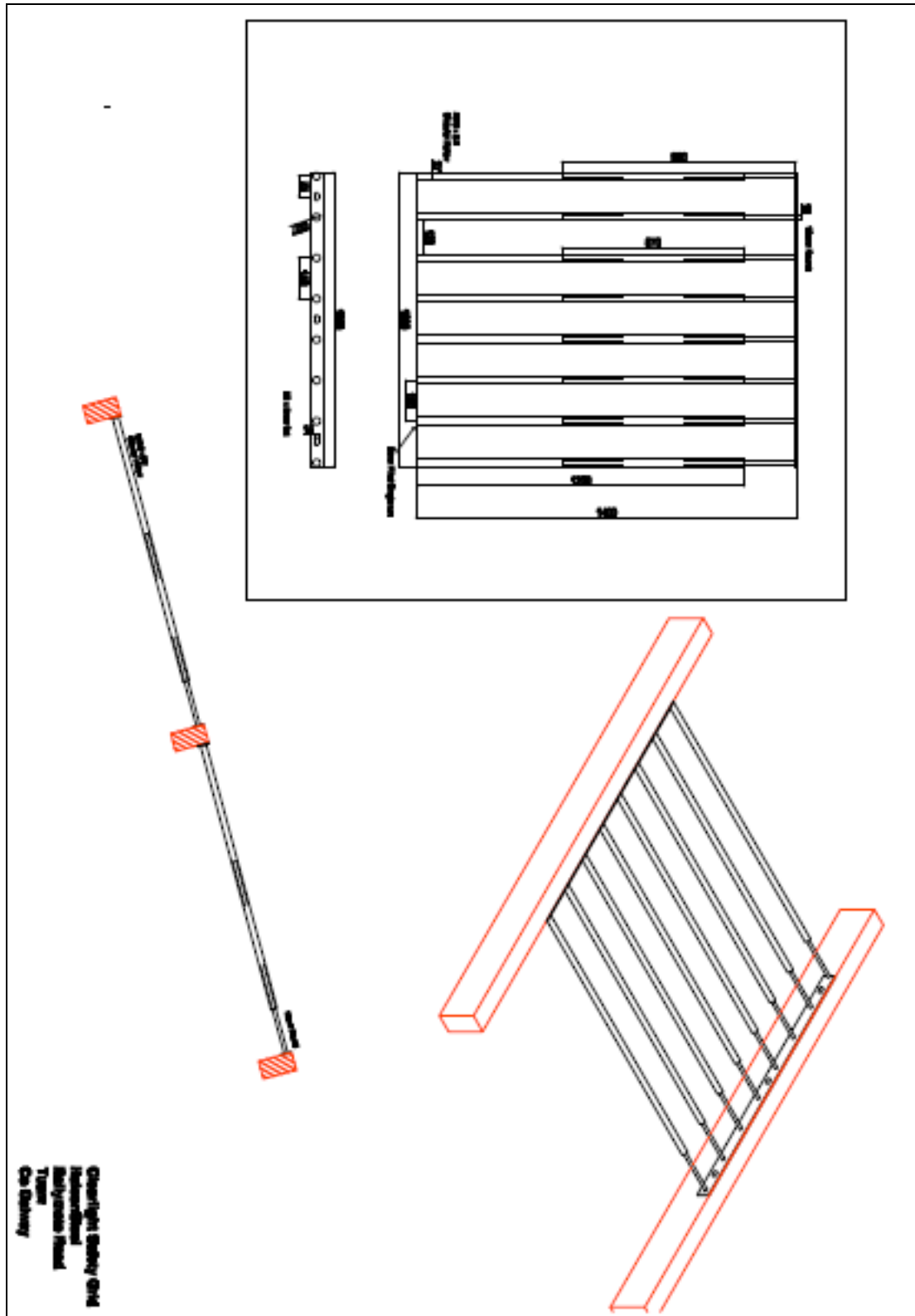

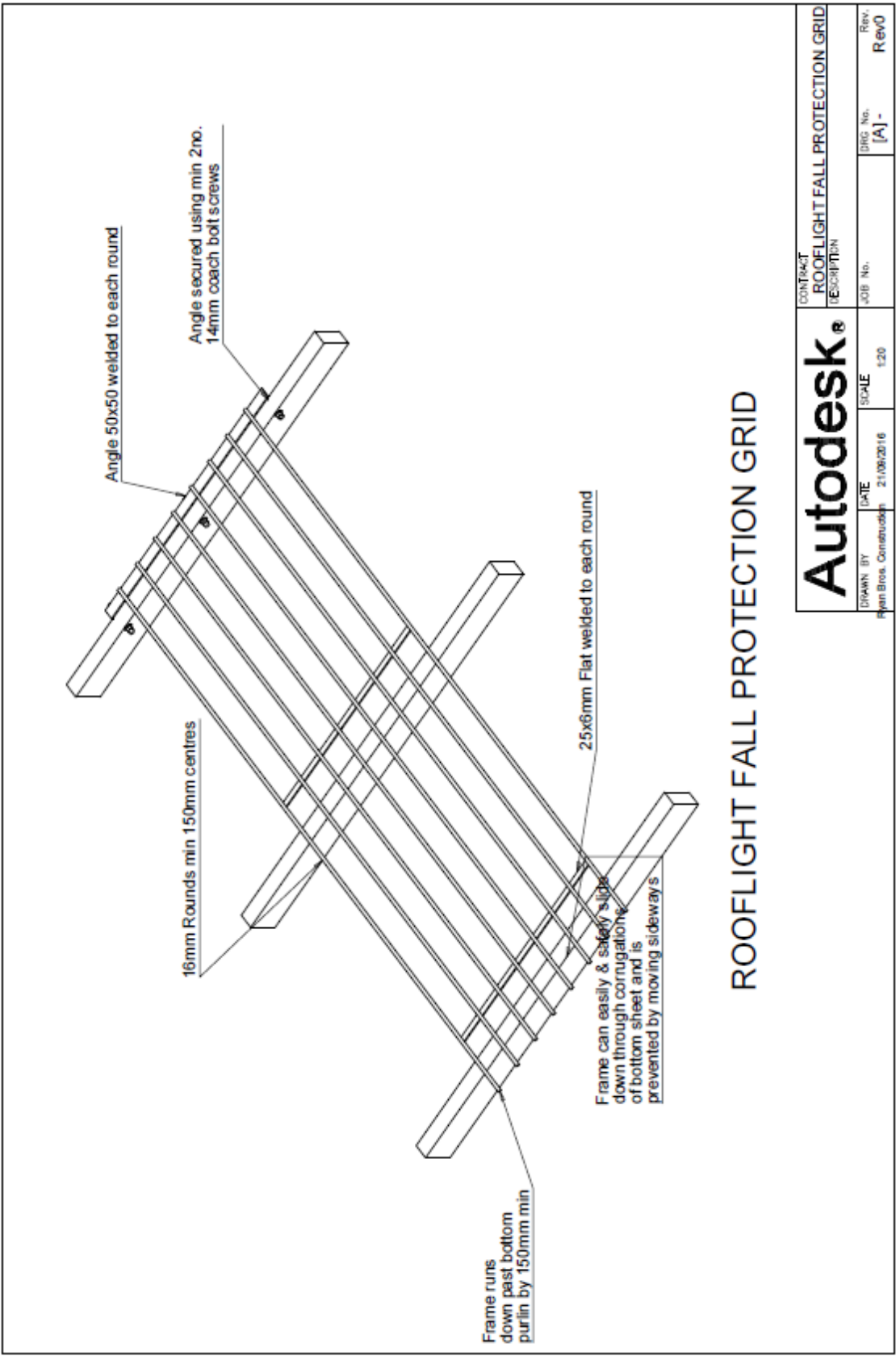

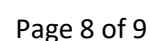
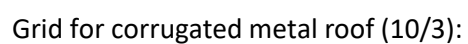
