Re: Multi-party Framework Agreement for Provision of Goods Contractors for Supply, Delivery, And Installation of Furniture to Laois County Council Premises within County Laois.

Laois County Council proposes to engage in a competitive tender process for the establishment of multi-party framework agreement for provision of goods contractors for supply, delivery, and installation of furniture to Laois County Council premises within County Laois.

Goods contract requirement to supply, delivery, and installation of furniture to Laois County Council premises at various location in County Laois, and at different building floor level (e.g. ground floor, first floor, second floor, etc.) during the framework duration. The scope of works may include but not limited to supply, delivery, and installation of furniture, it is also expected that contractor:

- Ensure all projects meet regulation standard and statutory requirements
- Ensure health and safety standards are maintain at all time
- Ensure all works are carried out in accordance with the public contract (Goods contract)
- Submission of material samples for approval
- Attendance of site meeting when required
- Other goods contractor duties as assigned by Laois County Council

Tendering goods Contractors are required to submit tender by completing attached documents, providing relevant requested documents, etc. All documents must be submitted in PDF.

It is anticipated that 2 tenderers will be invited to create a framework. The highest-ranking firms will form the framework containing 2 tenderers. Tenders scoring equal marks to the lowest successful tenderer will also be accepted. In such circumstances the framework members may increase. Firms admitted to the framework must have the resources and technical capacity to supply, deliver, and install furniture such as those included in the pricing document.

Suitable firms will be required to tender for projects as they arise and will have the necessary resources to deliver the project to the required standard.

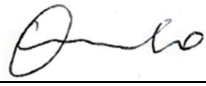


Goods contractor must be in a position to provide all required supplementary information and sign contracts within 1 week after letter of intent is issued by the Local Authority and to complete the project within the agreed project programme. Failure to commence work on the project within the 1 week timeframe outlined above will allow the Local Authority to offer the project to the next successful tenderer.

The framework duration will be 4 years, the budget for the framework is €250,000 excluding VAT and the framework will expire when the budget limit is reached or if the budget limit has not been spent and the framework maximum term of 4 years has elapsed.

Tenders must be received electronically via eTenders only by **16:00 hours on Tuesday 18th of August 2026**. Deadline for queries 28th of July 2026 at 16:00 hours.
