You are required by law to return all logbooks and all unused carcass tags to your local Inland Fisheries Ireland office or the Inland Fisheries Ireland office in whose River Basin District your licence was purchased. Logbooks and unused tags may be returned by post (a business reply envelope is provided) or in person. Logbooks and unused tags must be returned by October 19th of the year in which the licence is valid and/or catch information must be supplied as defined by the Wild Salmon and Sea Trout Tagging Scheme Regulations. The holder of the salmon and sea trout angler's logbook shall obtain a certificate or other proof of posting and shall retain such proof for 12 months.

The holder of a logbook should familiarise himself or herself with Section 69 of the Inland Fisheries Act, 2010 (No. 10 of 2010) and the Wild Salmon and Sea Trout Tagging Scheme Regulations in force at the time."

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ANGLERS

- Complete details of fish caught must be entered immediately after the fish is tagged or in the case of catch and release, immediately after the fish is released.
- This Logbook must be kept in your possession whilst angling and be available for inspection by Inland Fisheries Ireland Staff who may initial and date entries as required.
- If you run out of space on this logbook a continuation logbook should be obtained from an authorised agent or Inland Fisheries Ireland and completed accordingly.
- Each retained fish must be fitted with a sealed carcass tag on landing.** The code and number of the tag must be recorded in the logbook.
- Only tags issued to the logbook holder in accordance with the regulations may be affixed to fish captured by the logbook holder. Gill tags are not transferable between licence holders.
- Your logbook is to be certified by your signature.

DEFINITION OF THE TERM FISH

The term fish used above denotes wild sea trout (*Salmo trutta*) over 40 cm in length and any wild Atlantic salmon (*Salmo salar*).
