

Hi Michael,

I have attached a drawing of our BGS 200 passive grease trap which is suitable for overground installation. It is manufactured from 304 grade polished stainless steel and in accordance with IS EN 1825 (part 1&2)

The cost of this unit is €2,195.00 plus V.A.T. which includes delivery to site.

This grease trap does not require a power supply, daily maintenance and there is no requirement for the separate storage of waste oil.

Under the current guidelines of the Waste Discharge License now managed by Uisce Éireann, formally Irish Water, it is only necessary to connect the wash up sinks to the grease trap provided certain conditions are met.

Firstly, solid trays must be used when cooking meat or chicken in a Combi oven or Rotisserie oven. Greaseproof paper should be used where possible and discard all food waste into food waste bins. The trays should then be washed in a sink connected to a grease trap.

Secondly, all pots and utensils should be wiped with blue paper and then washed in a sink connected to a grease trap before being put into a dishwasher.

Also, the regulations with regard to the maintenance, pump out and disposal of waste from these Grease Traps, it is necessary that each unit is cleaned at least once every three months and documentation supplied by ourselves and signed by the site manager stating the amount of waste removed and disposed of.

Grease Trap Maintenance Program

- The Grease Trap is washed out and cleaned completely
- Vacuum drain lines to and from the Grease Trap
- The lid is placed back on the Grease Trap
- All waste is removed from the premises in an air tight container
- All waste is disposed of by means of an organic recycling
- Investigate any rodent activity around grease trap (where applicable)
- Report any defects with grease trap in writing to the person in charge
- Fill out and counter sign documentation with person in charge

Cost :- €220.00 per Pump Out plus V.A.T. @ 13.5%

BIO GREASE SOLUTIONS Ltd. undertake to supply you with Waste Removal Certificates for your files on payment of the invoice which is due on completion of the clean out.

It is the responsibility of the client to ensure the grease trap is in good working order, replace any Worn or Broken parts and take due care and attention as to what enters the grease trap.
