SCHEDULE 1 - REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the following:

- The provisions of the Sligo County Development Plan and the Collooney Village Plan 2024 – 2030,
- The existing pattern of development in the area,
- Art. 6.3 of EU Habitats Directive (Council Directive 92/43/EEC on the Conservation of Natural Habitats and of Wild Fauna and Flora),

It is considered that the proposed development, subject to compliance with the following conditions, would not be injurious to the amenities of the area, would not be prejudicial to public health, would not have an adverse impact on the Natura 2000 network, would be acceptable in terms of traffic safety and convenience and would be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

SCHEDULE 2 – SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS

- 1 The proposed development shall be carried out in accordance with the plans and particulars submitted to the Planning Authority on the 12th August 2025, save where amended by the following conditions.

Reason: In order to clarify the documents to which this permission relates and to enable Sligo County Council to check the development, when completed, with reference to approved particulars.

- 2 All construction/demolition waste associated with the development shall be disposed of in accordance with the requirements of national waste legislation. The applicant shall maintain waste disposal records for the duration of the construction phase of the development and these records shall be presented to the Planning Authority or authorised officers of Sligo County Council on request.

Reason: In the interest of proper waste management.

- 3 (a) Proper provision shall be made to ensure that no surface water is diverted or allowed to flow onto the adjoining public road.
- (b) Provision shall be made for the interception and disposal of surface water that may flow off the public road onto site, as a result of this development
- (c) The existing road drainage system shall not be obstructed by the development.

Reason In the interests of road safety and to prevent damage to the public road.
