The extent of the work includes (not limited to):

- Decommissioning and removal of existing oil-fired boiler plant and redundant services.
- Installation of new LPG-fired boiler plant and associated heating centre equipment.
- New external LPG storage tanks and underground LPG distribution services.
- Modification of existing LTHW heating distribution, controls and MCC.
- New flues, pressurisation, expansion and water treatment equipment.
- Associated electrical services and safety interfaces.
- Associated excavation, builders' works, making good and reinstatement.
- Testing, commissioning, certification and demonstration.
- 12-month Defects Period maintenance.
- All ancillary works required for a complete and operational installation.

To all Tendering Contractors,

You are invited to submit a tender for the proposed Heating Centre Upgrade Works at Bridgetown College, Bridgetown, Co. Wexford, under the Department of Education & Youth Emergency Works Scheme 2026.

All Tenderers are liable for their own costs of tendering. The appropriate Form of Contract for the construction project is the Short Public Works Contract (PW-CF6).

You are required to include in your tender for all necessary precautions under the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act and Regulations.

The successful Contractor will also be required to comply with the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations 2013 to 2021, particularly in relation to appointment as Project Supervisor for the Construction Stage (PSCS).

Acceptance of tender is dependent on the successful Contractor providing the necessary evidence of compliance, including insurances, tax clearance, previous works examples and health and safety information, within 7 days of the request being made.

Tender Submission

Tenderers shall refer to the eTenders CFT for the tender closing date and submission requirements. All tenders shall be submitted via eTenders in accordance with the requirements of the CFT and the Tender Submission Checklist.

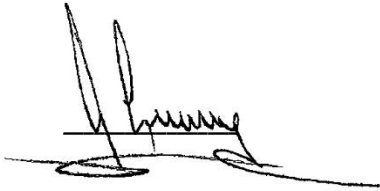
