WCC is seeking through this Tender a skilled person (or persons) to Coordinate this third phase, working in partnership with WCC Arts Office, other specialist personnel appointed for services such as evaluation or curation, members of West Wicklow Interagency Group, other partner organisations from the voluntary and community sector, local artists and the people who live and work in Baltinglass.
