Digital PEACEPLUS harnesses the potential of digital skills - animation, broadcasting, filmmaking, podcasting, games development - to bring people from diverse communities together through digital content creation. Together, they will create innovative content that reflects their new relationships - videos, animations, podcasts, games, etc. Participants develop a greater voice.
