Title: PIF 26/366 Request For Tenders to Establish a Single-Supplier Framework Agreement for the Provision of a Digital Mapping System for Atlantic Technological University (ATU)

Description: The Contracting Authority proposes to conduct a competitive procurement process under the Accelerated Open Procedure to establish a single operator framework agreement for the provision of a web-based digital wayfinding solution and associated services. The scope of the framework includes the design, development, deployment, configuration, implementation, and ongoing maintenance of the solution. The initial contract will comprise the design, deployment, configuration, and maintenance of the web-based digital wayfinding application, together with the creation of accurate indoor digital maps for all campuses within scope. These maps will include searchable points of interest (POIs), such as rooms, departments, facilities, amenities, and entrances. The solution must support safe and independent navigation for all users, with accessibility embedded as a core principle throughout the design, implementation, and support of the service. Justification for the accelerated procedure: The requirement was previously advertised through a competitive Open Procedure via eTenders, however, no contract was awarded following completion of the process. The service remains a critical requirement for Atlantic Technological University (ATU), supporting accessibility, wayfinding, navigation, and the overall campus experience across a number of ATU locations. Due to the previous unsuccessful tender process, delays have already been incurred in delivering this essential service. To mitigate further operational impact and ensure timely implementation, ATU are re-advertising the requirement using the Accelerated Open Procedure. This approach will reduce procurement timelines while continuing to ensure a competitive, transparent, and compliant procurement process in accordance with public procurement principles and requirements. The accelerated approach is considered necessary to address the urgency arising from the previous unsuccessful competition and to facilitate the prompt delivery of services that are important to students, staff, visitors, and other campus users across ATU.
