Justification for the duration of the framework agreement: A six-year term is required to ensure continuity and consistency in the BVMS learning environment. Maintaining the same simulation platform over this period will support the integration of simulation-based learning across the curriculum, clinical skills training, OSCEs, assessment, debriefing, and learner development. Changing the platform during this time could create educational, operational, technical, and financial challenges, including the need to migrate or recreate scenarios, assessments, learner records, reports, integrations, and staff training. A longer term will also allow the University to establish, operate, evaluate, and, where appropriate, expand the simulation environment while maximising the value of the initial investment. Any future expenditure or call-offs will remain subject to funding, approval, operational requirements, and the terms of the framework agreement.
