Incident and Accident Reporting: End-to-end reporting, tracking, and automated notifications. Action Tracking: Assignment, automated reminders, audit trails, and vehicle inspection management. Reporting: Custom organisational forms and databases for reporting and record keeping. Asset Management: Central asset repository with inspections, photo and GPS capture, inspection history, issue tracking with notifications, system integration, full data ownership/export, and mapped locations of equipment and facilities.
