Additional information: A contract was awarded to Causeway Geotech Ltd via mini competition CFT 6975182 For Ground Investigation Works: Coolock to Clontarf Active Travel Scheme Section 2 – Gracefield Road to Vernon Avenue at a value of €62,450 on 8th January 2026 Description of the procurement at the time of conclusion of the contract: To carry out ground investigation works along the route of the proposed Coolock to Clontarf Active Travel Scheme; on Brookwood Avenue, Sybil Hill Road and Vernon Avenue. Works consist of 4no. boreholes and 4no. slit trenches by means of mechanical excavation. A number of modifications became necessary after the award of contract. Description of the procurement after the modification: To carry out ground investigation works along the route of the proposed Coolock to Clontarf Active Travel Scheme; on Brookwood Avenue, Sybil Hill Road and Vernon Avenue. Works consist of 4no. boreholes and 4no. slit trenches by means of mechanical excavation. Also, to expedite delivery of the Chapelizod Road and Conyngham Road Active Travel Scheme, to carry out 2no. slit trenches in footpaths on Conyngham Road by means of mechanical excavation. The total value of modifications is

€80,175.00 Modifications became necessary to the original Contract, that were not included in the initial procurement, due to additional requirements requested by Dublin City Council's Roads Maintenance Division (DCC RMD) and Active Travel Programme Office (DCC AcTPRO). These changes are summarised as follows: 1) DCC RMD requested that the permanent reinstatements for each of the slit trenches on Brookwood Avenue be 10m long instead of 1m, that the old road surface be planed off and the new road surface be machine laid. 2) DCC RMD requested that the permanent reinstatements for each of the boreholes be at least 1m x 1m square in size, which is considerably larger than the 0.3m x 0.3m square the Contractor had assumed. 3) As the original Contract included provisions for working on Iarnród Éireann (IÉ) property, especially the elevated level of insurances required by IÉ, DCC AcTPRO deemed it prudent to add the excavation of slit trenches on the railway bridge on Conyngham Road to this Contract. This was in order to accelerate design work on the Chapelizod Road and Conyngham Road Active Travel Scheme. This modification is allowed under Directive 2014/24/EU Article 72.1. Contracts and framework agreements may be modified without a new procurement procedure 1(b) for additional works, services or supplies by the original contractor that have become necessary and that were not included in the initial procurement where a change of contractor: (i) cannot be made for economic or technical reasons such as requirements of interchangeability or interoperability with existing equipment, services or installations procured under the initial procurement; and (ii) would cause significant inconvenience or substantial duplication of costs for the contracting authority. However, any increase in price shall not exceed 50% of the value of the original contract. Where several successive modifications are made, that limitation shall apply to the value of each modification. Such consecutive modifications shall not be aimed at circumventing this Directive." Dublin City Council confirms that the value of each modification does not exceed 50% of the original contract value
